MIRADRY PATIENT REBATE PROGRAM TERMS AND CONDITIONS

This modal contains the official rules for the promotion.

The miraDry Patient Rebate Program is sponsored by miraDry, Inc. ("Sponsor"), 100 Bayview Circle, Ste 360, Newport Beach, CA 92660.

- 1. **PROGRAM PERIOD:** The Patient Rebate Program applies to Qualifying Treatments between June 1st, 2024 August 31st, 2024 (the "Program Period").
 - Sponsor reserves the right to modify or terminate this Patient Rebate Program at any time.
- 2. **ELIGIBILITY:** The Patient Rebate Program is open to legal residents of the fifty (50) United States, and Canada. Licensed health professionals, employees of licensed health professionals, employees of Sponsor, and employees of Administrator, are excluded from participating in the Patient Rebate Program. HOW TO PARTICIPATE: During the Program Period, a participant who undergoes the miraDry treatment performed by a miraDry provider enrolled in the Patient Rebate Program during the Program Period may be eligible to receive one (1) \$200 Visa® Prepaid Card. Upon completing a Qualifying Treatment, patient will receive a miraDry rebate voucher with a rebate code from their doctor and a link to the Patient Rebate site. An eligible participant must then complete and submit the registration page including but not limited to: his/her first and complete last name (no initials), valid e-mail address, phone number, provider name, receipt of treatment, and treatment dates. Participant must then follow the links and instructions to submit their rebate code by September 30st, 2024.

Upon verification of eligibility and rebate code, an eligible participant will be sent a \$200 Visa prepaid card. There is a limit of one (1) prepaid card per person. The approximate retail value of each prepaid card is \$200. Prepaid cards are subject to availability and only available while supplies last. Prepaid

cards will be emailed to the address provided upon registration within 30 days after redemption. No substitution or exchange will be allowed, except by Sponsor, who reserves the right to substitute a prepaid card of equal or greater value in case of unavailability of a prepaid card or force majeure (as defined in Section 4 of these Terms and Conditions).
